# **Sedalia Building and Construction Trades Council Scholarship Fund**

**ELIGIBILITY:** The Sedalia Building and Trades Council Scholarship Program is open to the sons and daughters who are legal dependents of Sedalia Building and Construction Trades Council Affiliated Local Unions' active members under the age of 24.

**SCHOLARSHIPS:** The maximum dollar amount granted to any one winner shall not exceed the total cost of the curriculum and must be applied directly to the cost of said curriculum. The number of scholarships (one time grants) and the amount of each scholarship will be determined and voted on by the body of the Sedalia Building Trades and Construction Council during the May meeting once all applications have been received. All scholarship awards shall be made out in the name of the applicant and the institution of learning he or she is/will be attending.

**STUDY REQUIREMENTS:** No specific studies are required. Scholarship winners may pursue whatever courses they wish. Applicants must be enrolled in a minimum of six (6) hours and accepted into or attending an accredited university, college, community college, an approved trade school, technical school, or a Union Apprenticeship no later than September 1<sup>st</sup> of the application year.

**APPLICATIONS:** Applications will be accepted during the months of February, March, and April of the application year. **ALL APPLICATIONS MUST BE COMPLETED AND POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN APRIL 30<sup>TH</sup> of the application year in order to be eligible for the current school year.**

Applications will be provided by contacting any delegate to the Sedalia Building and Trades Construction Trades Council

**SELECTIONS:** ALL qualified applications will be reviewed by the Council. The number of winners, as well as alternates for each of the winners, and the amount for each scholarship will be selected by a vote of the Council body at the May meeting.
